FLAVOUR PROFILE

Made from autochthonous Girgentina grapes from bushtrained vines, this steely and light dry wine is crisp with a fresh prickle that carries a delicate flowery arrangement of lemon blossom and other subtle citrus perfumes as well as fruity tangs of Granny Smith apple and crunchy Bambinella pear. The wine tastes remarkably fresh yet displays a mouthfeel that is unique for Girgentina.

WINEMAKER'S ACCOLADES

Although Girgentina and Melon de Bourgogne grapes are characteristically miles apart, the style of this unwooded Maltese wine is not unlike quality Muscadet: light-bodied and tart, citrusy and mineral. Delicata has gone the distance and used unique techniques to impart complexity. Sur lies is not emblematic for Maltese wines, but it is a significant part of the immediate appeal of Delicata's Girgentina varietal.
